

## **Provision**

**Provision for an identified child may take the form of one or more of the following:**

### **A. Strategies within the classroom**

**varied and flexible grouping within a year group  
vertical grouping across year groups when appropriate  
withdrawal of very able children for higher level work within small groups  
upward differentiation/extension in schemes of work  
teaching thinking skills in a subject context e.g. problem solving, decision making  
using Bloom's Taxonomy to ask higher order questions which encourage investigation and enquiry  
setting clear and challenging targets  
enabling children to evaluate their own work**
